Outer South Community Committee

Since 30th September 2024 report the Outer South Community Committee Facebook page has gained: **6 new followers** (and currently has) **1,555 followers** and has a **page reached** of **48,502** over the above period.

Facebook Page reach - The number of people who saw any content from or about your Page, including posts, stories, ads, social information from people who interact with your Page and more.

This means that this is the **fourth** most popular Community Committee page.

There are two things to note in general:

- 'reach' is the number of people the post was delivered to.
- 'engagement' is the number of reactions, comments or shares.

Engagement tends to be a better way of gauging if people are interested and have read the posts because they wouldn't have interacted with it otherwise. For example, a post might reach 1,000 people but if they all scroll past and don't read it, the engagement is 0 and it hasn't been an effective way for the Community Committee to communicate.

Having said that, all posts can be read without any further interaction!!


The most popular post since the 30th September 2024 report the posting regarding:


1st Place - Men's Pie Club - Employment and Skills Leeds

13,413 people had this post delivered to them and it had **8,916** Post Impressions & **8** Interactions.



2nd Place - Outer South Community Committee - Monday 2nd December 2024

1,827 people had this post delivered, with 1,183 Post Impressions & 6 Interactions



3rd Place - The Winter Wellbeing Event - 30th October 2024

1,033 people had this post delivered, with 661 Post Impressions and 11 Interactions.
