Good Morning,

I am writing to inform you of my objection to the variation of the times of the licensable activities at the above premises.

The basis for my objection is that the variation of the times of the licensable activities at the premises of Carousel & Home 117 Albion Steet, will further go against the licensing objective of the prevention of public nuisance.

The current problem with Home nightclub (and to a lesser extent Carousel) is not so much the volume of the music, but these premises have taken to cordoning off an area of the 'pavement' between the Light and the Cube (offices / K2 (residential) for outdoor smoking etc. (in particular, on a Wednesday when they run 'Voodoo' events) and the noise from their patrons (e.g. screaming, shouting and laughing in the street) is already causing a significant disturbance / nuisance until 3:00 – 4:00 am. Granting an extension to the licence will only exacerbate the problem.

Additionally, the premises are on the edge of a Cumulative Impact Policy area, and the approval of extended operating times will adversely affect the promotion of the licensing objectives.

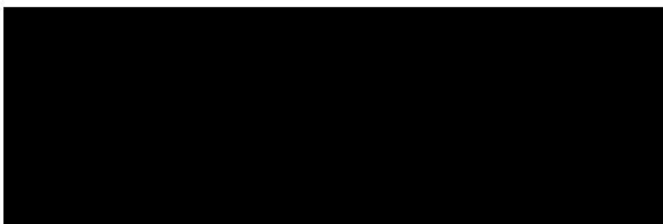
