Project Name: Restoration of Bramley Village Pump – and surrounds

Lead Organisation(s) : Area Management/ Bramley historical society

Project Summary (please include a brief description of the main activities and why this project is needed):

The Bramley Historical Society are seeking the restoration of the horse trough and village pump as well as repair or replacement of the metal fence that runs along the top of the retaining wall. The village pump dates from the Victoria era but is now badly corroded and has been neglected. The railings above the retaining wall are also badly corroded, date from the 1970s and do not reflect the historical significance of the area.

Area Management have met with the Historical Society and discussed what works need to be done to restore the area as it has historical significance to Bramley and Leeds (it was the site of the Leeds markets during the 1664 plague). The Bramley Historical Society would also like to put up a blue Civic History plaque to commemorate the sites significance. The two alcoves are Grade II listed monuments and any work that is to be done needs to be vetted by the Council's conservation team. Planning permission is needed for replacement of the fence and any work done to the village pump, although this is not required for the Civic Trust blue plaque.

- Part regeneration of Bramley Town Street
- Improvement in appearance of the approach to the Shopping centre
- Preservation and promotion of the history of Bramley.
