The DPPO for Armley Town Street has been in operation for just over 2 years.

We have given all local businesses a poster about the DPPO area and how to contact the police if there are issues of street drinking, and DPPO posters to Pubs and off licences. We are also currently exploring if we can design DPPO sticker for lampposts to compliment the street signs.

Project Summary (include a brief description of the main activities, why the project is needed and links to key priorities):

When the DPPO cam into force 12 DPPO signs where placed on Lampposts in the main the signs where placed at more prominent positions on Armley Town street/ Armley Moor area and main problem spots.

When issues arose of street drinking arose at the small park area at the junction of Armley Ridge Road an additional 3 DPPO signs added.

Over the 2 years the DPPO signs have some how disappeared. Having spoken to City Signs, it is not unusual for prohibition signs to be vandalised/stolen and we are now in a position where only 3 signs left, we are now requesting 20 signs.

Outcomes (summarise the main outcome/output/benefit the project will achieve): There have been new emerging issues with European street drinking particularly through day time hours on Armley Town Street.

With so few signs remaining informing people that they are in a Designated Public Place and that it is an offence to consume alcohol in this area the police have had difficulties in enforcing this, therefore additional signs have been requested by the police, ward members and businesses.
