Dear Sir,

I wish to complain about the traffic, and in particular the parking, when the number of children is increased at Whitkirk Primary School. I have no issue with the children, in fact I am a volunteer helper, hearing children read at the school.

As you can see from my address I live very near the school, and both traffic and street parking has increased very much since I came here thirteen years ago. Traffic into school starts at 7.00 a.m. until 6.00 p.m. This includes "out-of-school", taking care of children early morning and after school time for working parents. The street parking is at saturation point, so more children means more parked cars. As it is the teachers and staff have difficulty getting into school because of the up-and-down traffic and cars parked on both sides of the road. On my side of the road cars are parked on the kerb, sometimes leaving little space to pass, and people with pushchairs have to use the road. Neighbours have difficulty getting in or out of their drives, and a taxi parked across one. I have had part of my front wall knocked down by a parent backing with an open trunk.
