## EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

**This report introduces a presentation from the Director of Operations & Engineering from Leeds Bradford International Airport.**

### Purpose of This Report

- 1 The presentation is intended to provide an opportunity for members of the Area Committee to receive a presentation from Carl Lapworth, the Director of Operation & Engineering from Leeds Bradford International Airport.

- 2 **Background Information**

Concerns were raised at the March 29th Area Committee meeting about the levels of communication and advertising for the consultation process for the Airport's 'Draft Noise Action Plan'. In response to these concerns the Area Committee suggested that there was a need for a better consultation process between the airport and the local communities affected by the airport's day to day activities and that there needed to be in place an established consultative body for the local communities around issues such as airport noise, car parking and private flying. As a result the Area Committee invited a representative from the airport to attend the next meeting of the

Area Committee to discuss the consultation process and how a regular forum for such dialogue with the community and wider stakeholders could be established.
