# **Executive Summary**

This report informs members of an application for the grant of a premises licence for premises situated at 10 Lowtown, Pudsey, LS28 7AA, trading as Cafe Liqueur.

The premises propose to offer the licensable activities as detailed at 3.4 of this report and within the hours detailed in 3.5 of this report.

The premises were previously licensed and details of the licensable activities are at 2.1 of this report.

The responsible authorities are served with copies of the application by the applicant and Ward Members have been notified of the application.

#### 1.0 Purpose of this Report

- 1.1 To advise Members of an application made under section 17 of the Licensing Act 2003 ("the Act") for a premises licence in respect of the above mentioned premises.
- 1.2 Members are required to consider this application due to the receipt of representations.

# 2.0 History of Premises

2.1 This is the first application for this Premise since the previous Licence was surrendered.

Previously, the premises were only licensed for Sale by Retail of Alcohol (for consumption both on and off the premises)

Monday to Sunday: 11:00 - 22:00

- Members of the Licensing sub committee are asked to note that they may not modify the conditions or reject the whole or part of the application merely because it considers it desirable to do so. It must actually be <u>necessary</u> in order to promote the licensing objectives.







The application premise is currently vacant and was previously a café. This application is requesting opening hours from 08:00 to 00:30 7 days a week. The current planning approval is for A3 use only and allows for the premises to be open until 22:30 hours only. However it appears that this application is for the premises to be predominately a bar (A4 use) owing to the late opening hours applied for (including live music, dancing and sale of alcohol etc until 00:00 hours) and due to the very small kitchen shown on the plan.

In addition there is an adjoining flat to the rear of 12 Lowtown with other residential properties in close proximity which have the potential to be affected by noise from the licensable activities applied for.

Therefore Leeds City Council's health and environmental action service (HEAS) is of the opinion that your application contains insufficient information about how you intend to meet the licensing objective of the prevention of public nuisance. We write to inform you we shall be objecting to your application and a copy of this letter will be sent to the Licensing Authority.

The premises were granted planning permission for the change of use of retail showroom (A1 use) to café (A3 use) in February 2008 subject to a condition restricting the hours of use of the premises.

A further planning application was granted in May 2009 to vary the condition imposed on the previous planning approval. The current permitted hours of operation of the premises are;

"The opening hours of the premises shall be restricted to 06.30 hours to 22.30 hours Monday to Sunday."

Therefore the premises licence application as applied for the premises to operate until midnight 7 days a week is outside those hours permitted under the planning approval.

Also the plans provided as part of the licence application indicate that these premises are to be used as a drinking establishment rather than a café/restaurant. The use of the premises as a drinking establishment does not have planning permission.

The proposed hours of use set out in your premises license application exceed those allowed by the planning permission for the use of the premises as a café/restaurant. The use of the premises as a drinking establishment does not have planning permission.

The Development Department objects to the granting of a Premises License in the terms as applied for due to noise and disturbance being caused to nearby residential occupiers as a result of the comings and goings of customers and their motor vehicles, from customers congregating on the street in the vicinity of the building and from activities within the building. It is considered that the use of the premises as a drinking establishment and the opening hours applied for at these premises would conflict with the Licensing objective of preventing public nuisance.

The City Development Department considers that the unauthorised use of the premises and the extended opening hours proposed are unlikely to be acceptable and that a Premises Licence should not be granted.


