Project Name: Track & Jumps facilities

Lead Organisation: Pudsey & Bramley Athletics Club

Project Delivery - How will the project be delivered? (list any partners involved in the project):

The project will be delivered by Pudsey & Bramley Athletics Club in conjunction with Priesthorpe School who will be hosting the facility and Leeds Athletic Network.

Project Summary (include a brief description of the main activities,):

The project will create a 100-120m four lane straight, leading into large jumps pit will be marked out for the long jump, triple jump and all hurdle events from 60m up to 400m. The synthetic surface will enable all athletic drills to be carried out on a flat even surface. Sprint starts will be able to be practiced with the blocks having a secure footing and the athletes' spikes to be able to be practiced because all markings will be down. With this all weather surface, quality training can take place throughout the year.

With these new facilities, it is hoped that new members will be attracted by the diversity of events being coached at the club. The project will provide a safe environment for the coaching and practicing of numerous athletics events. There is no existing comparable provision within West Leeds.

Pudsey & Bramley Athletics Club has been based at Priesthorpe School for over 40 years and the school has guaranteed extra sessions so that the facility will be used to develop performance. In addition, pupils from the school will benefit from the project. The majority of junior members come from Calverley, Farsley, Pudsey, Bramley and Stanningley and some from Farnley and Wortley.

- Installation of track and jumps pit at Priesthorpe School
- New sports and community facility for West Leeds
- improved provision to develop young peoples' sporting potential
