Dear Sir,

I wish to make a formal objection to the License Application by the Adrian Social Club & Institute of 1A Belle View Avenue, LS8 2NN

**With reference to The sale by retail of alcohol till 1.00am**

I wish to make this objection under the criteria covered by the **Prevention of Crime and Disorder** for the following reasons :

- The club would be the only licensed premises open for the consumption of alcohol until 1.00am and people would travel in order to avail themselves of this facility; doubtless at this time in the night, drunkenness and its concomitant anti social behaviour would ensue. Considering that the club is in the centre of a residential area I object to this taking place between 1 and 1.30am if the license is extended to 1.00am.

I wish to make these objections under the criteria covered by the **Prevention of Nuisance**

- The noisy exit of many patrons from the club currently wakes me up in the night as I live diagonally opposite it. I do not wish to be disturbed an hour later when I am approaching a restful sleep mode.
- Residents do not wish to be disturbed an hour later by staff loudly disposing of quantities of empty bottles when they are approaching a restful sleep mode.
- There are several young children who live in the *immediate* vicinity of the Adrian Social Club. It is unfair to the residents to have their young children woken up at 1.30am as the patrons, who have had an hours` extra drinking time, leave the club and the empty bottles are discarded.

**I would also like clarification on the inclusion of `Dance` in the variation of the license.**
