There is no e-mail address for the applicant so I have posted a letter to her home address.

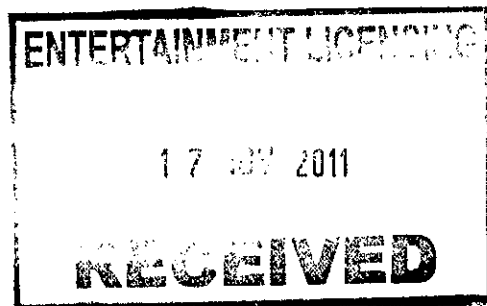

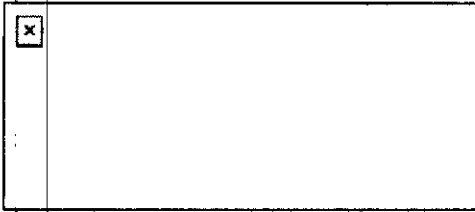

POLICE – LETTER OF OBJECTION

Thank you for submitting the application for the above mentioned premises, which we received at this address on 25th October 2011.

West Yorkshire Police object outright to this application for the following reasons:

Her Majesty's Revenue and Customs have raised concerns with West Yorkshire Police due to previous dealings with you. I am informed by their Specialist Investigations Unit that they have made several seizures of illegal sales of illicit cigarettes and tobacco from other premises for which you hold the premises licence, and also from the premises for which you now apply for a premises licence to sell alcohol.

I can provide details of the dates and seizure amounts at any licensing hearing which may be convened and I shall be calling an HMRC officer to give evidence of their dealings with you.

West Yorkshire Police have no confidence that the Licensing Objectives can be promoted by the granting of a premises licence under these circumstances. There is a clear undermining of the crime prevention objective. HMRC will provide a statement to confirm the above information, and if required will appear at any hearing in front of the Licensing Sub-Committee.

West Yorkshire Police therefore object outright to the application and would urge the Licensing Authority to refuse this application.
