

## Matters Arising from Meeting: 12<sup>th</sup> April 2012

Minute No.	Action to be taken	By whom	Outcome
1. Open Forum	<b>Kirkstall Lane Resurfacing:</b> Since the road was recently resurfaced the new road markings have changed a number of disabled parking bays into taxi parking. It is unclear where the authority for this has come from. Councillor Yeadon agreed to look into this issue.	Cllr Yeadon	This issue was raised with Highways and they inform us that although the usage of these parking bays has changed, additional disabled bays are due to be marked out closer to the stadium entrance imminently.
2. Matters Arising	<b>Park Wardens on Woodhouse Moor:</b> The meeting was pleased that the service would continue in 2012 but given the reduction from 7 days a week to 5, the Service was requested to be flexible given that patrols may not be necessary on some days due to weather conditions.	Cllr Harper	Parks & Countryside recognise the need for greater flexibility in service delivery due to peaks in demand on sunny days. They are currently in discussion with partners to determine how this can be achieved.
3. Matters Arising	<b>LDF Core Strategy Consultation:</b> It was noted that comments expressing concern at the lack of 'narrowing the gap' had not been referenced in the consultation feedback on the Core Strategy at the last meeting. Governance Services agreed highlight this omission to City Development.	Governance Services	Governance Services informed City Development of the omission of this point from the feedback to the LDF Core Strategy consultation.
4. Environmental Services Update	<b>Graffiti in Hyde Park:</b> Concern was raised regarding the large amounts of graffiti around the Hyde Park area. It was agreed to arrange for Ward Members and interested parties to undertake a walkabout of the area to view the extent of graffiti activity.  Issue of high level graffiti not being removed was raised as an issue. The Environmental Locality Team agreed to look into this.	AST/Locality Team  Locality Team	Cllr Akhtar and Jason Singh are currently in the process of arranging the walkabout with residents.  This will be covered under the Environmental Services report later on the agenda.
5. Children's Services Update	<b>Children's Services Report:</b> It was felt that the Children's Services report was too generic to the city and are therefore limited in their use to the Area Committee. It was asked that future reports included a localised element of what services were available for young people locally. The Area Support Team agreed to work with Children's Services to help tailor the reports to individual committees.	Children's Services / AST	A request for a localised element of what services were available for young people has been requested for inclusion and the Area Support Team has offered to work with Children's Services to help tailor the reports to individual committees.
6. WNWHL Update	<b>Morrisons Repairs:</b> Concern was raised at the ongoing problems with the repairs service being provided to WNWHL tenants by Morrisons. Mick Parker agreed to feed these ongoing concerns to WNWHL senior management.	Mick Parker	The ongoing concerns were fed back regarding the Morrisons contract and much work has been undertaken at a senior level to resolve the ongoing issues and an improvement plan has now been put in place.
