1. Open Forum	<u>Planning Application – Development of the former Leeds Girls High School site</u> - It was reported that SHCA was opposed to the above application in view of the proposed loss of sports facilities. SHCA was now seeking the support of the Area Committee in opposing the application. Those Members who had not declared an interest as members of Plans Panel (West) agreed to support the objection.		The planning application for the Victoria Road site should go to Plans Panel on 8 th November for determination and the Area Committee's views will be noted.
2. Open Forum	<u>Removal of Yorkshire Paving Stone and other Highways Issues</u> – A number of Highways issues were raised regarding both maintenance and road safety across the area. The Area Committee requested Highways attend a future meeting to discuss these.	Highways	Highways will attend a future meeting of the Area Committee.
3. Children's Services Update Report	<u>Additional Information Request</u> – A request was made that further data be provided around apprenticeships and in particular were these schemes being secured by local people	Children's Services	Further information has been received and has been circulated to committee members.
4. New Generation Transport (NGT)	<u>NGT Update</u> – The NGT Team presented a report which provided an update on the scheme. This included details of the rationale behind the remobilisation of the NGT scheme, since receiving confirmation from the Government that the scheme would potentially receive government funding. The Area Committee requested that further information/clarification be provided in relation to: impact of land take at Woodhouse Moor/ Headingley Hill, possible loss of trees along the Headingley corridor and arrangements for cyclists. Wellbeing Fund 2012/13	<u>Additional Funding for allocation</u> – It was reported that following a review of wellbeing revenue approvals between 2004/5 to 2011/12 an under spend of £918.00 had been identified.
