Summary of main issues

- 1. At its September meeting, the Scrutiny Board acknowledged the start of a 12-week consultation exercise being undertaken by the West Yorkshire Fire and Rescue Authority on proposed changes to emergency cover in West Yorkshire. The Scrutiny Board agreed to consider these proposals and respond to the consultation.
- 2. The District Commander, Chief Finance Officer and the Deputy Chief Fire officer of West Yorkshire Fire and Rescue Service attended the Board's meeting on 22nd October 2012 to present an overview of the proposed changes and discuss how these will affect services within the Leeds area in particular.
