Premises Summary

The application premises has been operating for some time as a private members club within the small town of Garforth, Leeds. The application premises is situated on the Main Street, although when facing the club from Main Street there is residential housing in very close proximity to the rear.

The submitted application is to change from a club premises licence to a general premises licence. The application also seeks to provide live music until midnight, recorded music until 1am, and increase the hours for the supply of alcohol until 1am as well. The new opening hours would be until 01.30 in the morning. This would appear to be a significant increase in the existing terminal hours.

This Department has not previously received complaints from nearby residents in relation to noise from the club. However, it is likely that the existing hours for live music and supply of alcohol until no later than 11pm have helped considerably with this.

The applicant describes these change as allowing the club to rent out the premises to non members, and describes the type of functions under consideration as "funeral tea's". Unfortunately, the changes as applied for would also permit loud music type events typical of 21st birthday parties etc. Activities, including the coming and going of patrons and people smoking outside, may occur until 01.30 in the morning.

If granted the application is likely to increase the number of events that take place at the premises as well as the hours these will finish. There may well be an increase in the number of patrons using the outside areas, especially late at night or in the early hours of the morning. Therefore, there is a greater potential for public nuisance to nearby residents if this application is granted. The applicant has submitted a proforma of measures they intend to incorporate into their operating schedule. Unfortunately these measures do not address all the public nuisance issues that are likely to occur at this premises.

Having considered the application under the Licensing Act 2003 for the above premises, the Leeds City Council's environmental action service considers that the following measures are proportionate and necessary in order to promote the following licensing objective:

I refer to your e mail below in response to my letter of 14/02/13.

I am pleased of your acceptance of my proposed conditions 3 and 4.

Your application is to change from a club premises licence to a general premises licence, and increase the hours for the supply of alcohol and live music. The application form describes these changes as allowing the use of the club by non members for functions etc. If granted I would consider that the application is likely to increase the number of events that take place at the premises as well as the hours these will finish. There may well be an increase in the number of patrons using the outside areas, especially late at night or in the early hours of the morning. Therefore, there is a greater potential for public nuisance to nearby residents if this application is granted.

However, I do note the lack of previous complaints in relation to your existing operations. Therefore, I am accepting of your proposed changes to my original conditions. The new conditions being:

- 1. The opening hours of the premises shall be restricted to 10.00 to 00.30 the following day.
- 2. The hours of licensable activity at of the premises shall be restricted to 10.00 to 00.00 for the sale of alcohol, and 10.00 to 00.00 Monday to Saturday and 10.00 to 23.00 on Sundays for regulated entertainment.
- 3. Noise from a licensable activity at the premises will not be audible at the nearest noise sensitive premises, which are residential properties immediately to the East on Lyndon Avenue and Coupland Road.
- 4. Between 23.00 and 10.00 the following day, smoking by patrons shall only be permitted in the area immediately to the front of the premises which faces onto Main Street.
